The Children's Hospital has developed leading-edge services and centres of competence in several areas, including organ transplantation (lung, heart, kidneys, liver), endocrinology and diabetology, gastroenterology, orthopedics, cardiology, respiratory medicine or neonatology. It receives more than 50,000 patients per year for outpatient and takes care of 10,000 children and adolescents hospitalized for more than 24 hours.
